### What is eComStation Entry?

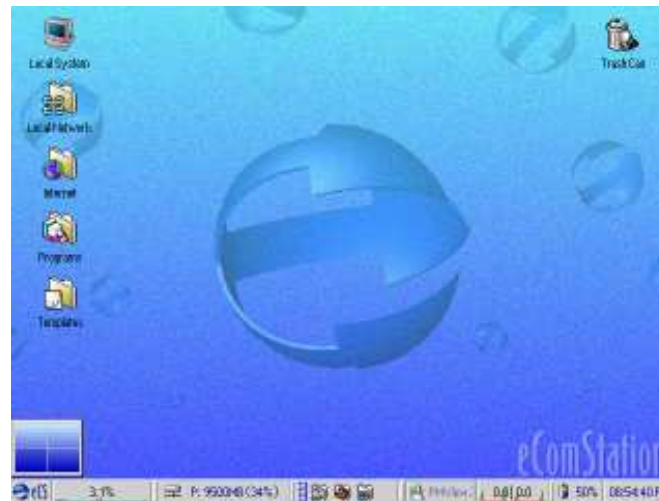
Many users expressed a desire to see the Operating System component of eComStation separated from the expense of the bundled applications, such as Lotus SmartSuite. These users may have already had the applications they needed, or they just wanted a less expensive product. In response to this input, the new eComStation Entry branding is essentially the Operating System component, though it is still rich in applications and utilities. However, commercial applications like Applause, Smart Suite, and HOBLINK may now be ordered separately as the **Application Pack**.

**eCS Server Edition** is a complete Network Operating System based on IBM network technology providing an application server foundation with integrated file and print sharing, backup and recovery connections systems management, advanced printing, and Internet access, including one of the best TCP/IP stacks available in the industry.
